

# Making Sense of Counterwill

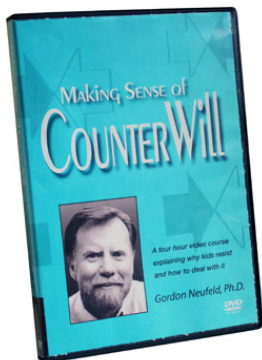

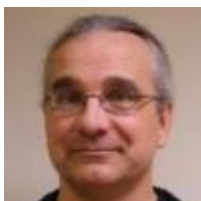
